Steve has been a member of the police force for 26 years, joining in 1982 and has an impressive resume covering Criminal Investigation Units, Crime Squads, Regional Response Units primarily investigating drug related matters, sexual offence and child abuse. Adding further Officer in Charge of the Armed Offenders and Prison Squads, and was also seconded to Operation Pendennis, joint counter terrorism with members from Victoria Police, Australian Federal Police and ASIO for 2 years. Steve has been in charge of the Homicide Squad for 2 ½ years and this year was awarded the Australian Police Medal for Services to the Community. It certainly is nice to know that we have men like our speaker to protect us from criminals and to solve those nasty crimes. We welcomed Acting Superintendent Detective Inspector Stephen Clark he spoke on "Shootings in the Melbourne Central Business District". This was a very enlightening presentation, another world to most Probrians.
