"A spanner in the works"

A most interesting talk told via a series of photographs about the tragically short life of Alice Anderson, who in 1919 started the first all women garage in Cotham Road Kew.

She was the first woman to have a business card having done an apprenticeship to become a mechanic. She also invented the "get out and get under" a wooden trolley with leather headrest for getting under a car.

She repaired vehicles, chauffeured interstate trips, apprenticed young woman. Alice died of a gunshot wound to the head at the age of 29.
